#### **Italy: Main legislative drivers**

#### Italian WFL (DLGS 152/06) requires Municipalities/District-Areas to:


- reduce by 2012 disposal to 35% of total MSW (total sep. coll. min 65%)
- Collection of Biowaste with reusable bins and/or compostable bags;
- Increases landfill-cost by 20% for WM districts not complying to recycling target

#### **Updates about IT legislation after 2018:**

- by Jan-2022 mandatory separate collection of biowaste
- Incentive for biogas from biowaste & upgrading to biomethane

## **Modern MSW management in Italy**





#### **Convenient tools to sort biowaste (food waste)**

#### Sorting at home

- Vented kitchen caddies
- Compostable bioplastic
- For <u>each</u> household



#### **Delivery to the collection**

- In line with weekly production of a standard family
- Manual emptying
- High-density waste (it's wet food....)





#### Since 2015: new collection tools for residual waste





- 1 x 40 liter per family
- TAG RFID
- Collection services are traced
- Collection frequencies are low (i.e. 1/2weeks) compared to standard (i.e. 1/week)



## **Hardware on board and tracking of collection services**


Low-cost small truck are used for door-to-door collection

#### Pantelleria: key data





#### Separate collection year 2017, Island of Pantelleria (IT)




#### Lessons to be learned

- User-responsible collection scheme
- Never collect Food waste without a bucket/bin
- Choose the correct volumes
- Vented kitchen caddies need compostable liners
  - Paper
  - Bioplastics
- Food waste recycled at combined AD&Composting facilities (production of biomethan & compost)
- Financial analysis of MSW services (including 3-years plan)
- Application of PAYT charges (about ¼ of municipalities) on residual waste
